## **Twelfth Night Feast Impressions by Sir Michael Sinestro**

The following announcements were made at the March 1, 2003 estates meeting.

1.It was announced that the next Umbrian Estates Meeting will be taking place on Saturday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2003 at 10:00 a.m. for the following: any estate business and the approving of contenders for the next Crown War.

2. Crown War is scheduled for May 2<sup>nd</sup> through May 4<sup>th</sup> as a camping event tentatively set for Estrella Park (Sir Puck is in the process of making final arrangements).

3.Scenarios for Crown War will be made available sometime at the beginning of April.

4. Contenders for the Crown War must make their declarations to the Chancellor's office between the dates of March 19 – April 3 in order to be considered at the

April 5<sup>th</sup> Estates Meeting. Late entries will not be allowed to run per Umbrian Law.

5. Crown War Archery will be done on site at Estrella Park. This will be a first for Umbria.

6. Umbrian Civil Court to be held after the Estates Meeting on April 5<sup>th</sup> and **will take as long as necessary**. This is a public court so anyone interested in watching the event are welcome to attend.

7. Imperial Committee Meeting will be Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

### STEWARD SAYS

Good people of Umbria please note the following list of expirations ranging from those that are currently in their grace period to upcoming expirations (unless they have paid directly to the Imperial Steward, of course!). The following reflects local records and Imperial records as of 3/04/03).

#### Membership by check

If you pay for your membership by check, please note that it will take approximately six to eight weeks to process your check due to administrative procedure (membership checks are not allowed to be deposited locally and must be submitted to Imperial Steward's office for deposit). Likewise, if you bounce your membership check, you will have to deal directly with the Imperial Steward's Office. If you have any questions please do not hesitate in speaking with the Steward.

#### Imperial Website:

Also please note, that due to administrative procedure, updates to the Imperial Membership website maintained by the Imperial Steward does not always reflect the most current information. Meaning, if you see your name as being either in your grace period or currently expired and you know that you have **paid locally, you are considered to be a paid member in good standing**. Monthly paperwork (reports and memberships and so forth) is forwarded the following month and received by the Imperial Steward's Office for processing by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.

So, for example, if you paid your membership to the local steward in January, your membership will not be

processed and updated in to the Imperial website until sometime after the 15<sup>th</sup> of February. Imperial Steward's Office may make several updates a month while the office processes through the various kingdoms', duchies', shires' paperwork.

#### Estate Management:

For reference for estate holders in managing their estates: If there is a member shown on the Imperial Steward's website as being expired, meaning they have gone past the 30 day grace period that member should not be counted in an estate. Just because that person may still be shown on the Imperial website doesn't make them a member in good standing (if you think they have paid locally/imperially please ask the local steward to verify). The non-current member may remain on the website (an administrative procedure) for a while just to make it easier on the Imperial Steward's Office to maintain the website if the non-member decides to renew his/her membership.

It is recommended that the local government work together (i.e., the offices of the Chancery, Steward, and Rolls) to main the most accurate information that may be distributed for its local members. (Granted the Imperial Steward's Office will have final say in matters pertaining to qualifications being met in running for local/imperial Crown.) The local office of the Steward should be utilized for local matters (i.e., estate management, rolls).

#### 30-Day Grace Period:

Per the Steward's Manual 1999 (Part III. PROCEDURES, C. REGISTRATION OF MEMBERS), Members whose membership is up for renewal are given a thirty (30) day grace period in which to pay their dues. If they pay after the thirty (30) day grace period, treat the membership as if it was a new membership; remember there are offices, which have time requirements as "a member in good standing". Once someone has expired and gone past the grace period, the timer starts over.

#### Sidenote:

If you pay directly to the Imperial Steward could you please forward a copy of your membership and drop me a line via e-mail or in person, so I may update the local

Steward database. Thank you!

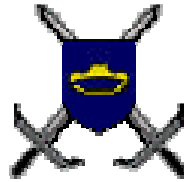
